

Dress Code Frequently Asked Questions

1. May students wear clothing with logos (e.g., Adidas, Nike, Under Armour, etc.)?

Yes. Brand logos will be allowed on clothing with the exception of logos related to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, weapons, violence, vulgar or obscene language, political statements, and race, religion, gender, or ethnicity.

2. Are “slogans” allowed in the dress code?

Yes. Slogans are allowed as long as they are not distasteful or offensive. Slogans related to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, weapons, violence, vulgar or obscene language, political statements, and race, religion, gender, or ethnicity will not be allowed.

The following are examples of allowable slogans:



3. Will holes or tears be allowed in clothing?

No. Clothing may not include tears or holes. However, frays are allowed.

4. Are students allowed to wear backless shoes?

Hard soled, backless shoes are allowed except slippers, house shoes, flip-flops and athletic slides.

Example of hard soled backless shoe:



5. May students wear basketball style shorts?

Athletic style shorts are allowed as long as they are:

- Not more than 3 inches above the knee;
- Not oversized or baggy; and
- Worn at the waist or above the waist.

6. May students wear leggings?

- No. Students may not wear clothing that is considered leggings.
