What is the WiFi Username \ Password?

The following chart will help you to determine the proper username and password combination to connect to the wireless network.

Employees and Secondary Students:

When your password expires (every 45 days), you will need to forget the NISD_WiFi network on your personal device and then reconnect to NISD_WiFi following these directions.



Connecting with Windows 8


1. Select the **Wireless Network** Icon on the Taskbar




2. Select **NISD_WiFi** from the list of available wireless networks and select **Connect**


4. When prompted to “Continue Connecting?” click **Connect**.


Connecting with Windows 10

2. Select **NISD_WiFi** from the list of available wireless networks and select **Connect**


Wireless Network Connection


4. When prompted to “Continue Connecting?” click **Connect**.

Connecting with Apple iOS


1. Navigate to **Settings > Wi-Fi** on your iPhone, iPad, or iPod

4. When the **sso-svr.nederland.k12.tx.us** Certificate appears, select **Trust**.





Connecting with Mac OS X


1. Navigate to **System Preferences > Network**


Connecting with Android OS

3. Fill in the following settings and select **Connect**:

Phase 2 authentication:	MSCHAPV2
CA Certificate:	Do Not Validate
Identity:	<i>Your Network Username/Guest Account Username</i>
Anonymous identity:	LEAVE BLANK
Password:	<i>Your Network Password/Guest Account Password</i>



Personal Chrome OS Devices Only – District Chrome Devices are Pre-Configured


1. In the lower right hand corner of the screen, select the settings area.
